Critical care: the eight vital signs of patient monitoring Abstract Nurses have traditionally relied on five vital signs to assess their patients: temperature, pulse, blood pressure, respiratory rate and oxygen saturation However, as patients hospitalised today are sicker than in the past, these vital signs may not be adequate to identify
